

# Desert Pines Golf Course Policies

**Weather Policy.** RAIN does not constitute cancellation of a golf event unless the golf course is determined to be closed by the course officials. The General Manager, Director of Golf, and/or the Head Golf Professional are the only people authorized to officially close the golf course. Should severe weather, frost, or other circumstances beyond the control of course management result in closure of the facility during the tournament group's scheduled day or days of play, the following procedure is agreed to:

Nine holes or 2 ½ hours played by all participants constitutes a completed golf tournament.

If the Golf Course General Manager or Head Golf Professional cancels the Tournament because of weather conditions before 9 holes are completed, the Tournament will be rescheduled.

Closure of the facility is at the sole discretion of Arcis. Arcis reserves the right to restrict golf carts to cart path only due to inclement weather, overseeding, and/or any other condition at the sole discretion of Arcis.

**Spikeless Facility:** Arcis does not allow metal spikes to be worn on the golf course.

**Speed of Play:** The required pace of play on the golf course is a maximum of 15 minutes per hole (i.e. 4 1/2 hours to complete 18 holes). If a group falls behind this pace, some or all of the groups will be requested to move to the next hole. Foursome pairings are strongly encouraged. Other pairing requests must be pre-approved by the General Manager.

**Food and Beverage:** Arcis has the exclusive right to provide food and beverage on the premises. All food and beverage must be purchased through Arcis at the property. We reserve the right to confiscate food or beverages that are brought onto Arcis property without written consent of Arcis management. All food and beverages must be consumed during the times specified for your event and may not be removed from the property.

**Dress Code:** Proper golf attire must be worn at all times. All players are required to wear collared shirts. Slacks, shorts, or skirts must be hemmed and in good condition. Recommended short/skirt length is mid-thigh. Tank tops, swimwear, cutoffs, gym shorts and the like are not acceptable.

**Clubs:** Each player is required to have their own golf bag and set of clubs. Rental sets are available for anyone who does not have their own set of clubs for an additional charge. Tournament client is responsible for all charges if rental sets are not returned to the Pro Shop in their entirety.

**Disorderly Conduct:** All golfers are expected to conduct themselves in a civilized manner in accordance with USGA rules of etiquette and conduct. Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated. Participants acting disorderly will be removed from the premises.

**Golf Carts:** All golfers must abide by the safety warnings on each golf cart. Only two riders per cart and at no time should any participant ride on the back of a cart. If any participant does not know how to operate a golf cart then please have them see one of the Arcis staff for a tutorial. Golf carts should only be operated by persons with a state issued driver's license.

**ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE SERVICES:** It is the policy of the golf course to serve alcohol in a responsible manner. Arcis is responsible for the sale and service of alcoholic beverages as regulated by State Law. The Arcis' alcoholic beverage license requires the Arcis to (1) request proper proof of legal age to consume alcohol, (2) refuse alcoholic beverage service if the person cannot provide the proper identification, and (3) refuse alcoholic beverage service to any person who, in the Arcis' judgment, appears intoxicated. Please note that all alcoholic beverages served on the Premises must be provided by the Golf Course and dispensed by the Golf Course staff only. No flasks or shots are permitted on the Premises. Upon request, Arcis can offer to secure a cab or ride service for any guest who is intoxicated.
