



SPECIAL EVENTS COMMITTEE CHARTER

Purpose

The Special Events Committee shall identify opportunities for education/networking outside of the annual convention.

Membership

The board will appoint the committee chair and members and each will serve a term of one year. The board may fill vacancies on the committee and may remove a member from the committee at any time without cause.

The committee shall have a minimum of three members and a maximum of five members.

All members of the committee shall be NACA members in good standing.

Authority

The committee has no expressed or implied power or authority.

Responsibilities

- Assist in planning education and social events to enhance NACA's member benefits.
- Identify and recommend financial resources required to be included in NACA's annual budget.
- Oversee the planning of educational content for training webinars.

Meetings

The committee shall meet monthly. A majority of the committee members shall constitute a quorum. The committee chair will keep a copy of the committee meeting minutes and forward a copy to the board secretary. The committee chair may invite any director, officer, staff member, expert, or other advisor who isn't a member of the committee to attend, but these individuals have no voting power.



The committee will review its charter annually and recommend any proposed changes to the board for review.
